Curriculum

- All teachers participate in monthly professional development in the areas of math, literacy, SIOP, and gifted and talent strategies
- All paraprofessional have monthly in-services
- In the last 2 years we have implemented research based programs in literacy and math
- We follow the 3 tier model of supporting the students
- Continue to implement art integration
- Emphasizing healthy life styles

Computers and Technology

- The school has 6 mobile labs plus classroom computers
- Students spend about 1.5 hours per week on the computers
- Classrooms are equipped with enhanced sound systems
- Each classroom has an interactive Promethean board
- Six eMints classrooms with 2 additional soon

Successes

- Implementation of Professional Learning Communities - Teachers meet weekly (40 min.) to discuss student needs, crucial concepts, common assessments, enrichment and reteaching.
- eMints classrooms – The use of technology is an important part of their classroom learning.
- School choir – We have on the average 50 students participate in our school choir. Each year we have students chosen to join others from around the world in the International Kodaly Choir.
- School wide academic growth in math and language arts

Extracurricular Programs

After School Program –
 Approximately 150 students are served Monday - Thursday in the early morning school program. The students have extensive tutoring in reading, math and also a homework lab. The enrichment program after school include ballroom dancing, luna sticks, knitting, sports, iMovies, choir, student council, orchestra, art and others.
